Archaeological evidence of the Roman Fort and Settlement has been placed under the care of the Cheshire Museum Service and Chester Grosvenor Museum.

Some of the 'finds' uncovered in Middlewich are currently on display at Middlewich Library.

Artefacts on display include:

- The Middlewich hoard of silver denarii
- Roman military discharge diploma
- Examples of Samian ware and other locally made pottery items
- Leather shoes
- Large amphora from Spain
- Brooches and much more...

Information panels tell you about the development of the settlement and a life size model of a Roman Auxiliary Soldier shows what they would have been wearing in Britain.
