



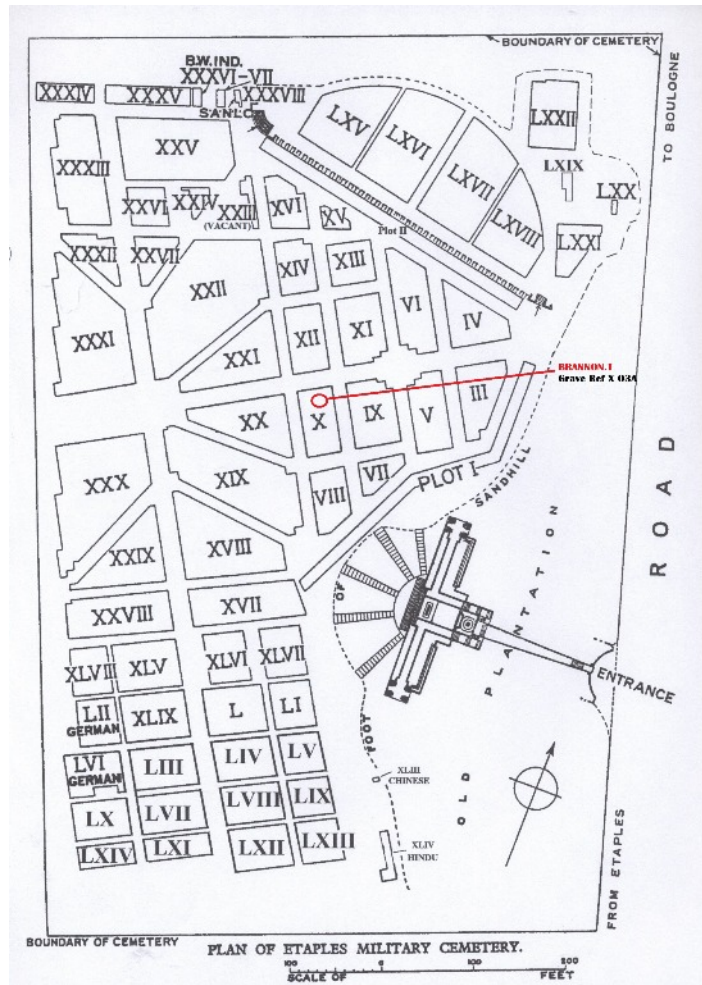

BRADLEY, Capt. George Joseph. 2nd/2nd Bn. London Regt. (R. Fus.), transf. to 211th Div. Employment Coy. Labour Corps. Died of bronchopneumonia 17th Feb., 1919. Age 46. Husband of A. E. Bradley, of "Gisburn," Trinity Rd., Southchurch, Southend, Essex. XLV. B. 14.

- BRADY, Rfn. John, 54175. 2nd Bn. King's Royal Rifle Corps. Died of wounds 23rd Oct., 1918. Age 22. Only son of Mr. and Mrs. T. Brady, of 1, Coustonhill St., Pollokshaws, Glasgow. LXVI. K. 12.
BRADY, Pte. J., 17335. 10th Bn. Loyal North Lancs. Regt. 15th April, 1916. Age 20. Son of William and Mary Brady, of Astley Bridge, Bolton. V. A. 21.
BRADY, Pte. J., 31647. 42nd Field Amb. Royal Army Medical Corps. 29th Sept., 1915. IV. H. 14A.
