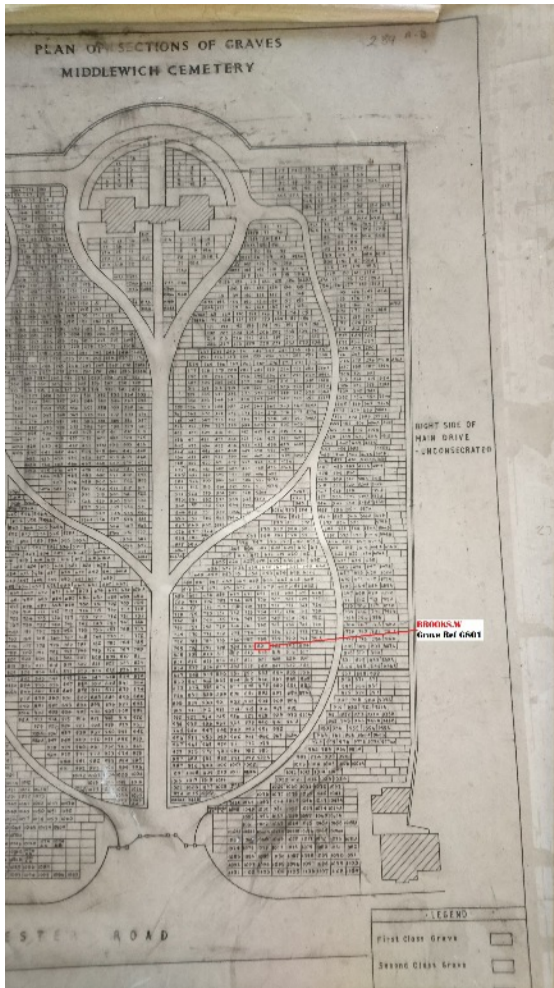

BRAZIER, Gnr. F., 204733. R.A. and T.C. Command Depot, Royal Garrison Artillery. 26th Nov., 1918. Age 34. Son of Charles and Daisy Mabel Brazier; husband of Ellen Brazier, of 17, Lever St., Middlewich. C. 672.

BROOKS, Serjt. W., 2687. Royal Air Force. 27th Nov. 1920. Age 25. Husband of Olive Brooks, of 67, Wheelock St., Middlewich. G. 801.

CLARKE, A. M. L. F., 43903. Royal Air Force. 8th April, 1920. C. 712.

COPPENHALL, Pte. William, 13280. 12th Bn. Cheshire Regt. Died of malaria 18th Nov., 1919. Age 29. Son of Philip and Hannah Coppenhall, of 1, St. Anne's Rd., Middlewich. G. 438.

DODD, Dvr. John James, T4/109228. 333rd Coy. Royal Army Service Corps. Died of accidental injuries 27th Aug., 1915. Age 19. Son of Jonathan and Elizabeth Dodd, of 28, Booth Lane, Cledford, Middlewich. C. 212.

FRENCH, 2nd Lt. G. H. Royal Field Artillery. 26th June, 1919. G. 630.

HATTON, Pte. R. T., 17658. Depot, Lancashire Fusiliers. 16th Feb., 1920. Age 46. C. 521.

HOUGH, Pte. H. P., 253327. Royal Air Force. 20th Oct., 1918. G. 435.

JOHNSON, Pte. H., M1/40497. King's Shropshire Light Inf. and Royal Army Service Corps. 16th May, 1921. Husband of Julia Lythall (formerly Johnson), of 7, Opposite Electro Offices, Cledford, Middlewich. C. 191.

KIRK, Pte. J. H., 11336. 8th Bn. Cheshire Regt. 12th July, 1919. Age 37. Son of Thomas and Sarah Kirk, of Hawthorne Cottages, Middlewich; husband of Martha Ann Kirk, of 79, Wheelock St., Middlewich. C. 530.

MANN, 2nd Lt. George Bertram. 9th Bn. Royal Fusiliers. Died of wounds (gas) 29th Sept., 1918. Age 23. Son of George Herbert and Annie Mann, of High Town, Middlewich. C. 655.

POOLE, Dvr. Jacob Allen, 121517. 11th Div. Ammunition Col. Royal Field Artillery. Died of wounds 6th July, 1917. Age 35. C. 225.

SNELSON, Serjt. Ernest, 13903. "A" Coy. 11th Depot Bn. Royal Welch Fusiliers. 4th Sept., 1918. Age 27. Son of George Henry and Ellen Snelson; husband of Mary Ellen Beasley (formerly Snelson), of 414, Sutton Lane, Middlewich. G. 361.

STUBBS, Pte. Joseph, 34858. 26th (Tyne-side Irish) Bn. Northumberland Fusiliers. Died of wounds 28th April, 1917. Age 21. Son of Samuel and Margaret Ann Stubbs of Church View, Holmes Chapel, Cheshire. G. 609.

SWAIN, C.O.M.S. W. H., 12980. 9th Bn. Cheshire Regt. Died of meningitis 11th Jan., 1915. Age 38. Son of William Swain and Mary Swain; husband of Mable Louise Swain, of 64, Easton Rd., New Ferry, Cheshire. Born at Rose Heath, Sandbach. C. 802.

WRIGHT, Pte. Ph. S., 256399. Reserve Supply Depot, Royal Army Service Corps. 23rd June, 1917. C. 554.
