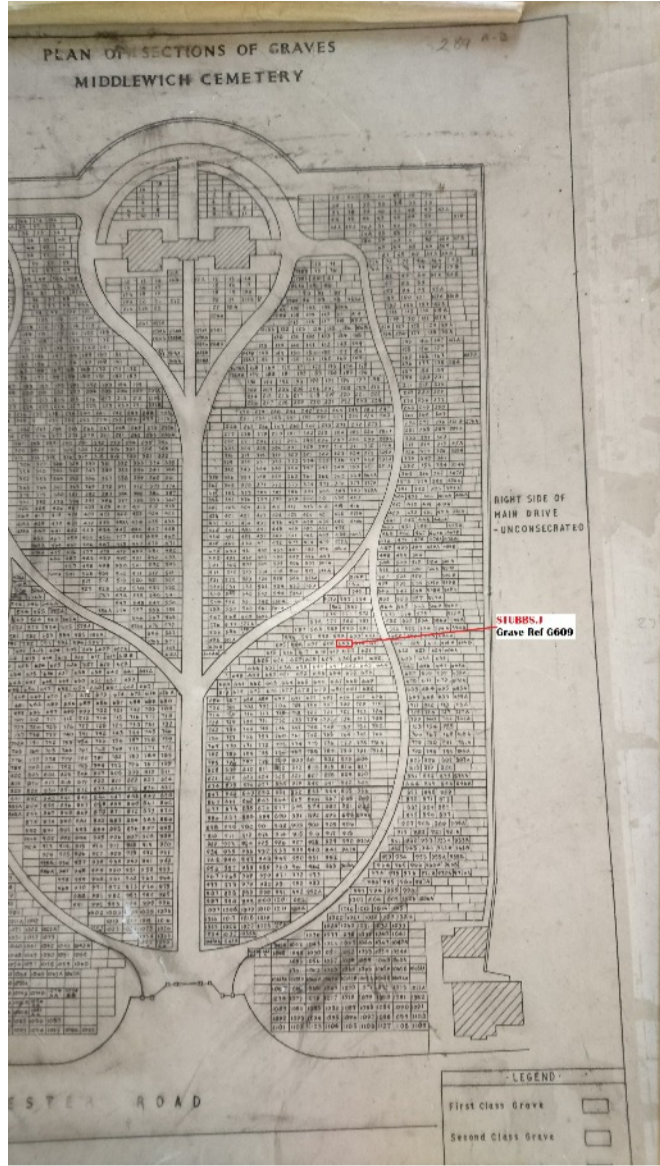

MIDDLEWICH URBAN DISTRICT. MIDDLEWICH CEMETERY, at Newton, was made in 1807. It belongs to the Middlewich Joint Burial Committee (for Middlewich and five other parishes). (It was formerly the burial place of the 17th Bn. Cheshire Regt.) BAILEY, Pte. D., 77345. 3rd Bn. Cheshire Regt. Died of pneumonia 11th July, 1918. Age 18. Son of Daniel and Jane Bailey, of 6, Lower St., Middlewich. C. 437.

BRAZIER, Gnr. F., 204733. R.A. and T.C. Command Depot, Royal Garrison Artillery. 26th Nov, 1918. Age 34. Son of Charles and Daisy Mabel Brazier; husband of Ellen Brazier, of 17, Lower St., Middlewich. C. 672.

BROOKS, Serjt. W., 2587. Royal Air Force. 27th Nov, 1920. Age 25. Husband of Olive Brooks, of 67, Wheelock St., Middlewich. G. 801.

CLARKE, A.M.I., 45993. Royal Air Force. 8th April, 1920. C. 712.

HOUGH, Pte. H. P., 233327. Royal Air Force. 20th Oct, 1918. G. 435. (Royal Army Service Corps. 1917. (formerly 1918))

JOHNSON, Pte. H., M/20037. King's Shropshire Light Inf. and Royal Army Service Corps. 16th May, 1921. Husband of Julia Lythall (formerly Johnson), of 7, Opposite Electric Offices, Clefford, Middlewich. C. 191.

KIRK, Pte. J. H., 11336. 8th Bn. Cheshire Regt. 12th July, 1919. Age 37. Son of Thomas and Sarah Kirk, of Hawthorne Cottages, Middlewich; husband of Martha Ann Kirk, of 79, Wheelock St., Middlewich. C. 530.

MANN, 2nd Lt. George Bertram. 9th Bn. Royal Fusiliers. Died of wounds (2nd) 20th Sept, 1919. Age 23. Son of George Herbert and Annie Mann, of High Town, Middlewich. C. 653.

POOLE, Dvr. Jacob Allen, 121517. 11th Div. Ammunition Col. Royal Field Artillery. Died of wounds 6th July, 1917. Age 35. C. 225.

SNELSON, Serjt. Ernest, 13993. "A" Coy. 11th Depot. Bn. Royal Welch Fusiliers. 4th Sept, 1918. Age 27. Son of George Henry and Ellen Snelson; husband of Mary Ellen Bentley (formerly Snelson), of 114, Sutton Lane, Middlewich. G. 361.
