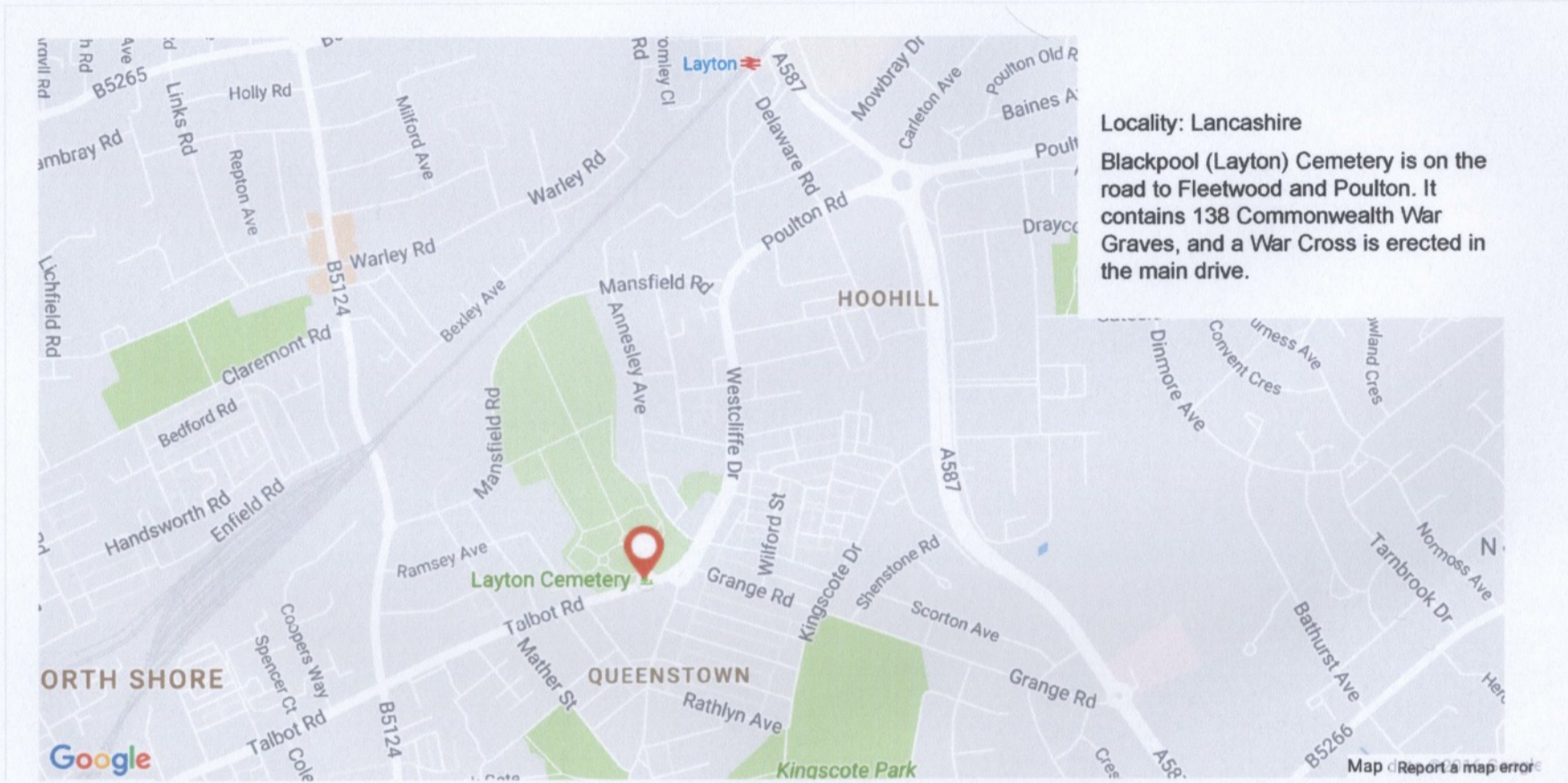

WARWICK, Lce. Cpl. James, P/317. Military Mounted Police, Military Police Corps. Died of sickness 22nd Nov., 1918. Age 37. Son of Joseph and Elizabeth Warwick, husband of Mrs. F. Garrett (formerly Warwick), of 6, Empire Grove, New Rd., Blackpool. Born at Canonbie, Dumfriesshire. K. 813.

WHELPTON (served at LAWRENCE), Serjt. Frank, 17651. Depot, King's Own Yorkshire Light Inf. Died of wounds 9th Aug., 1916. Age 35. Son of George and Ann Whelpton. W. 159.

WHITTAKER, 2nd Lt. Fred Poulton. No. 54 Training Depot Station, Royal Air Force, formerly 8th Bn. Manchester Regt. Killed while flying (crashed) 25th Oct., 1918. Age 22. Son of Orlando and Grace Whittaker, of 24, Regent Rd., Blackpool. Y. 207.

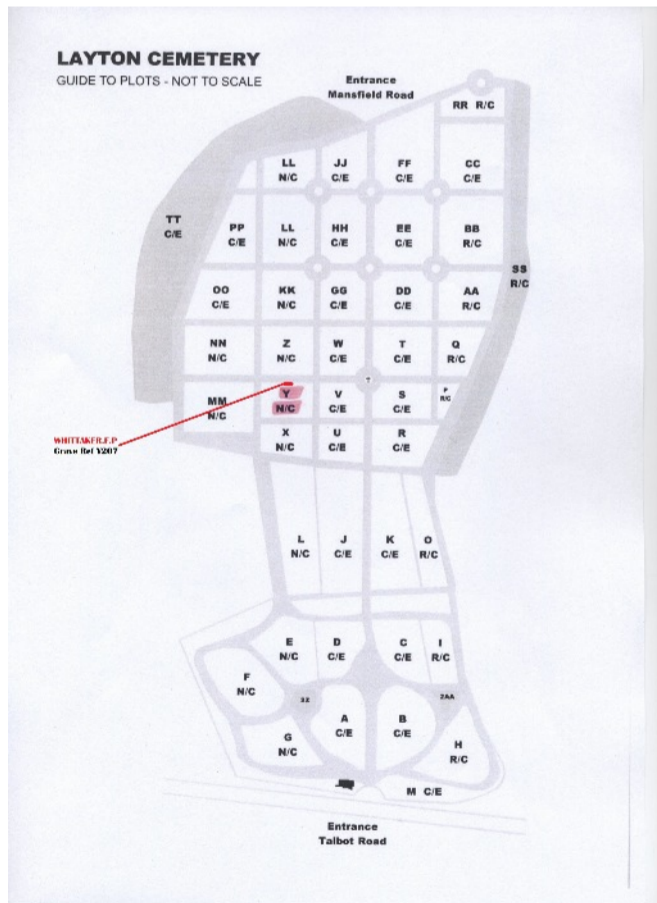
